





HISTORY OF THE WORLD'S BIGGEST FISH FRY

The "Fish Fry" evolved from "Mule Day," which originated in 1938 with the Paris Post Intelligencer as the first sponsor. Farmers came to town on the first Monday in April to trade their mules and other farm products, do their shopping, and enjoy the fellowship of their friends. Early in the 1950's, the Chamber of Commerce took over "Mule Day" and the tractors took the place of mules. The Chamber of Commerce started looking for another event to replace "Mule Day."

In 1953, the Chamber of Commerce held the first "Fish Fry." The event was not as successful as hoped. The fish were not taken from Kentucky Lake and just did not please the fish eating public. The parade was short but sweet, and the event was held on Barton Field for one day and night.

In 1961, the Paris-Henry County Jaycees took over the "Fish Fry" from the Chamber of Commerce. The "Fish Fry" was starting to grow too much for the Chamber to handle, so the Jaycees (Junior Chamber of Commerce) took over the event, taking the name of "World's Biggest Fish Fry," an event that truly lives up to its name.

Since 1961, the "World's Biggest Fish Fry" has grown considerably – from 1,600 pounds to over 5 tons of catfish being cooked and served at the Robert E. "Bobby" Cox Memorial Fish Tent.

Community participation and support of the "World's Biggest Fish Fry" unites the community in many ways. Community involvement by attending one of the seven beauty pageants, buying souvenirs, eating fish dinners, attending the rodeo, entering or watching the Grand Parade or the Small Fry Parade, and going to the carnival makes the event successful.



The history of the "Fish Fry" started with the farmers and their mules. Each past "Fish Fry" makes new history by trying new and different things, increased attendance, more catfish served, and more community involvement.

The Paris-Henry County Jaycees hope to make the "World's Biggest Fish Fry" bigger and better each year.

Bart Herbison

A Paris, Tenn., native, Bart Herbison spent 14 years in commercial radio at WTRP, WAKQ and WMUF in Paris. He worked as a reporter and as a correspondent for The Nashville Banner newspaper and Tennessee Radio Network before joining the administration of former Tennessee Governor Ned McWherter as Deputy Director of Communications in 1987. Herbison then served as Press Secretary, Campaign Manager and Chief Tennessee Administrative Officer for U.S. Rep. Bob Clement (Nashville) in from 1988-1997 when he left DC's Capitol Hill for Music Row.

Herbison is Executive Director of the Nashville Songwriters Association International (NSAI), the world's largest not-for-profit songwriters trade organization and advocacy group. Established in 1967, NSAI's membership spans the United States and several other countries. With nearly one hundred chapters, they serve aspiring and professional songwriters in all genres of music. NSAI also owns The Bluebird Cafe in Nashville, Tennessee.





Under Herbison's leadership NSAI gained prominence in the national legislative arena. Accomplishments include:

- Adoption of the "Music Modernization Act" in 2018, the most important copyright law reform for songwriters in decades.
- Creation of the Mechanical Licensing Collective (MLC) of which he is a board member.
- Led NSAI's involvement in the 2016 Copyright Royalty Board (CRB) trial that led to a 44% mechanical royalty increase for American songwriters, the largest in history, translating up to an estimated \$10-12 billion in increased royalties 2024-2027.
- Passage of the landmark "Songwriters Capital Gains Tax Equity Act" in 2006.
- Creation of the first-ever Group Copyright Infringement Insurance for songwriters with Frost Specialty Inc.
- Acquisition of the world-famous "Bluebird Café" in 2008.
- Purchase of the "Music Mill" studios as NSAI headquarters in 2005.

In 2018 Herbison received two prestigious national honors for his songwriter

advocacy work -- the "Industry Legacy Award" from the National Music Publishers Association (NMPA) and the "IP Champion's Award" from the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Global Innovation Policy Center. In 2020 the Los Angeles Chapter of the Assn. of Independent Music Publishers (AIMP) recognized Bart for his advocacy work and in 2021 he received the "Arnold Broido Award" for Copyright Advocacy from the Music Publishers Assn. (MPA). In 2024 Bart was bestowed the prestigious "Bob Kingsley Living Legend Award" to benefit the Grand Old Opry Trust Fund.


Appearing in his first movie role, Herbison portrayed himself in the 2017 film "Wheeler" starring Stephen Dorff. He is featured in the documentaries "The Last Songwriter" released in 2018 and "It All Begins With A Song" where he also served as Assistant Executive Producer. In 2009 Bart was one of the original seven inductees in the Henry County High School Speech and Theater Wall of Fame in Paris, Tennessee for his successes in debate and extemporaneous speaking and subsequent accomplishments. Herbison hosts the video/print interview series "Story Behind the Song" appearing in The Tennessean and other Gannett newspapers.

Mark Herbison

Mark Herbison is the son of JB. Herbison and Carol Stigall and grew up in Paris with his brothers Bart and Jon and sister, Lori. He has more than 30 years of economic development and governmental experience with an emphasis on business recruitment, retention, and expansion programs.

Early in his career, Herbison spent time as a disk jockey at WMUF, WTPR, WIN 107 and as a statewide radio news reporter with the Tennessee Radio Network. After leaving radio, Herbison served for nearly 10 years in various roles within the Tennessee Secretary of State's office in Nashville, including public information officer, assistant director of publications and as administrative assistant to the Secretary of State. In 1996, Herbison coauthored a book entitled "Looking Back at Tennessee," that was published by Hillsboro Press.



Prior to his current role as President of the newly formed Tipton County Community Development Council in July 2024, Herbison served as President of HTL Advantage, a three-county industrial development agency serving Haywood, Tipton, and Lauderdale Counties in West Tennessee. HTL was the agency responsible for the local level recruitment of Ford Blue Oval City to the Memphis Regional Megasite in 2021. The Blue Oval City project is the largest project in history for both the state of Tennessee and Ford and is expected to create over 10,000 high quality manufacturing jobs in the next three years.



During his economic development career, Herbison has managed over a thousand projects that have resulted in over 45,000 new jobs and over \$15 billion in capital investment.


